

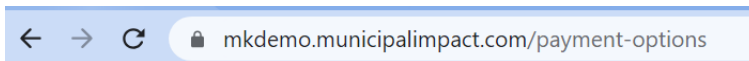
## How to Create a Button - Muni

### Step 1: Copy the Link for Your Button

- To create a button that when clicked takes the user to a specific page, first we need to find the **URL** for that page
- In the example below, we want the button to take the viewer to the **Payment Options** page on the drop-down list under the **Residents** tab, so click **Residents** on the **Navigation toolbar**, then click **Payment Options**



- **Copy the URL** from the top of your PC's browser (see below)



- In the example above, the URL is **https://mkdemo.municipalimpact.com/payment-options**

### Step 2: Login to Client Dashboard on Your Website

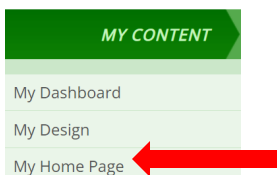
- In the lower right corner of your website's Home page, you will see the word **Admin**



- **Click that link**, then login to your **Client Dashboard** with your username and password

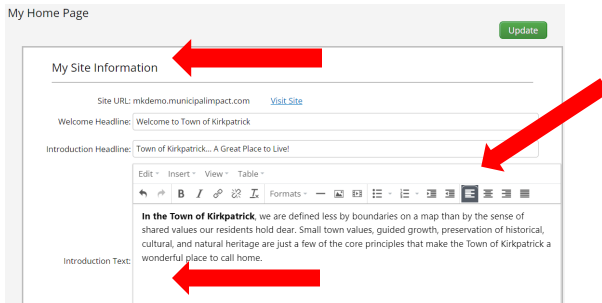
### Step 3: Add a Button to a Page on Your Website

- On the **Client Dashboard**, navigate to the page where you want the button to appear

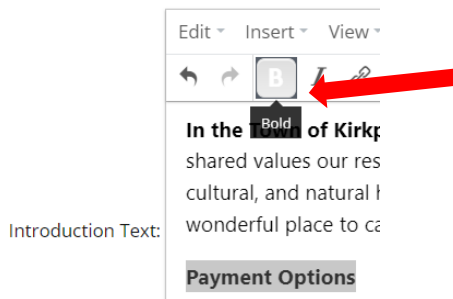


- In the example above, we want the button to appear on the **Home** page, so **click My Home Page** on the left side of the screen

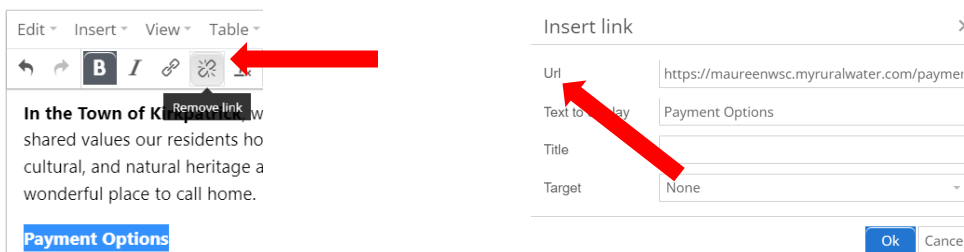
- In the text box for the **My Site Information** section, place your cursor where you want to add the button, then **click the Align left, center or right icon on the toolbar** to choose the button alignment (in the example below, the **cursor is under the paragraph** and **Align left** was chosen)



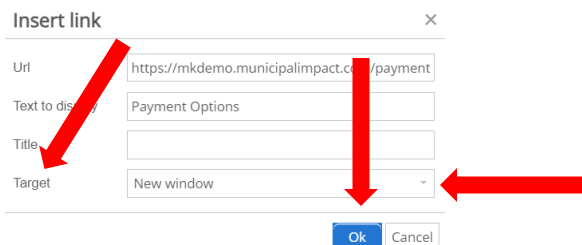
- Type the text you want for the button label, then **select/highlight the text** and **click the B icon on the toolbar** to make the text bold



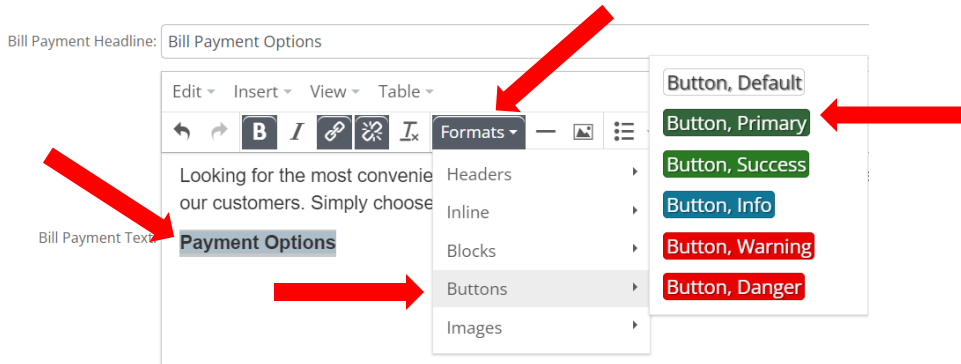
- With the text still highlighted, **click the chain link icon (insert/edit link)**, then **paste the destination URL** from Step 1 above in the URL box (see Insert link pop up box below)



- **Select New window** on the Target drop-down menu, (a new browser tab will open when the button is clicked), then click the **Ok button**



- With the text still highlighted, **click Formats** on the toolbar, **click Buttons** on the drop-down list, **click the type of button** you want, then **click the Update button** at the top or bottom of the screen



- Click **Visit Site** to see the button labelled **Payment Options** on your **Home** page
